#### **Research Articles and Guides**

- **1.** All **Mark Allen Healthcare articles** related to COVID-19, ICU skills, PPE and hand hygiene are currently free to access on a dedicated <u>COVID-19 page</u>.
- 2. <u>COVID-19 literature searches bank</u> a central repository for expert searches carried out by professional healthcare librarians across the country. Search topics covered include:
  - Guidance on how to clean IT equipment
  - Management of cardiac arrest and outcomes for infected patients (viral infection)
  - Trends in presentation to ED with COVID-19

# eBooks on Mobile App or Desktop (free access extended to 31st July)

Indextra's digital healthcare library is currently available via mobile app or desktop. It is recommended for clinical staff, especially those returning to practice, final year students now required to work on the front-line, and all others requiring access to clinical textbooks. So far over 300 consultants and 130 junior doctors employed by LGT have been registered to use Indextra online.


